Dear Property Owner:

The City of Cokato has the majority of completed on the street project in front of your property. We would like to point out two items regarding the project; Sidewalks and Street Snowplowing.

Sidewalks – Please try to refrain from putting large amounts of ice melt products on the sidewalk this winter as it affects the new poured concrete and can leave pits in the sidewalk in the forthcoming years. We would advise using sand on sidewalks instead.

Street Snowplowing – Edge of Curb – The contractor will come back in the spring of 2021 to finish the roadway making the asphalt even with the edge of the curb. In the meantime, the gutter will be 1 to 2 inches higher.

In order to not damage the new curb, the City snow plows will need to stay away from the curb edge this winter which could leave some snow next to curb and it will be up to the homeowner to remove this snow.
