RESOLUTION REJECTING BIDS FOR 2020 WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DIRECTING RE-ADVERTISEMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to an advertisement for bids for the City of Cokato’s (the “City”) 2020 Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvement Project (the “Project”), bids were received, opened and tabulated by City staff and the City’s consulting engineer from Bolton & Menk on the 5th day of May, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the bid advertisement and bid instructions for the Project explicitly provide that the City reserves the right to reject all bids.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cokato as follows:

1. All bids received for the Project are hereby rejected. City staff and consultants, as the case may be, shall return all bid securities provided to the City in response to the solicitation of bids for said Project.
2. City staff and consultants shall proceed to re-advertise to solicit bids for the Project as soon as reasonably practical and in accordance with law.
